Humphreys Condemns Terrorist Sympathizers Organizing Palestinian Rallies Over Memorial Day Weekend

(Eagle, Idaho) Ed Humphreys, GOP candidate for Governor, is calling on Idahoans to reject a two-day anti-Semitic rally in Boise promoted by groups like Black Lives Matter and NAKBA 73 who have been actively working to dismantle the country of Israel and support terrorist activities against the Jewish people.

"Every Idahoan, every Jew, and Christian in Idaho should be outraged by terrorist sympathizers in Idaho promoting anti-Semitic rhetoric and celebrating their goal of wiping Israel off the map," Humphreys said.

The two-day Black Lives Matter/NAKBA 73 sponsored event will happen Friday and Saturday in Cecil Andrus Park in Boise.

"Where are our leaders and how do they respond to this blatant pro-terrorist movement in the Gem State? As Governor, I will leave no doubt in Idahoans' minds that they have a leader who believes in liberty and will condemn these and other Marxist/Socialist movements in the strongest possible terms," Humphreys added.
