Humphreys Reacts to GOP Members of Congress Calling for an End to Canadian Lumber Tariffs

(Eagle, Idaho) Ed Humphreys, GOP Candidate for Governor reacted to calls this week by Republican members of Congress calling for an end to the Canadian lumber tariffs for their pervasive subsidies for its softwood lumber industry:

"The U.S. International Trade Commission has consistently found that the Canadian government provides massive subsidies to its lumber industry and the dumping of lumber products in the U.S. market by Canadian companies causes real harm to Idaho producers and those workers and business that support the Idaho timber industry," Humphreys said.
